1. Prompt

Reflection: Obligatory. This course carries Ole Core Power and Race. One of their Intended Learning Outcomes (ILOs) states students can "reflect critically on how racism, ethnocentrism, power, privilege, and inequality shape their own individual experiences and the experiences of others." What did you become aware of linking yourself and others regarding power, race, and language in your day-to-day experiences? Write a short reflection on your own position relative to power and privilege and how this shapes your perspective and relations to others. Use a specific example from the readings or presentations to compose your reflection.
