GUIDELINES FOR COMMUNICATING WITH 9-1-1 OPERATORS

Speak clearly and directly to the 9-1-1 operator.

Don't talk with other people or put the operator on hold.

Provide the following information:

- Building name
- Street address or intersection
- Room number
- City/State

Provide details about the emergency

- The type of emergency: medical, fire, and/or police
- What you see, hear, and/or smell
- Number of people needing assistance, if known
- The type(s) of injuries, if known
- Where to enter building & find the injured

Answer all questions the 9-1-1 operator asks.

S/He will communicate that information to the responding rescue personnel.

Stay on the line until directed to hang up, since the operator may be able to provide important instructions before emergency personnel arrive.
