

2019 OLECHESS CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please read these rules and regulations carefully and bring them with you to camp. OleChess believes that good camp discipline is an essential component to a successful camp.

1. Conduct yourself with dignity and in the spirit of good sportsmanship at all times.
2. All campers under the age of 18 are required to stay on the St. Olaf campus. Minors must present a written note from a parent to the camp director for permission to leave campus.
3. Attendance is required at all tournament rounds, instructional sessions, and special activities. Any camper needing to be excused due to illness must first report to a member of the camp staff.
4. All campers under the age of 18 must observe the daily check in procedures described in the *OleChess* 2018 Handbook.
5. Smoking is prohibited in all St. Olaf buildings and near all building entrances. The use of alcohol or illegal drugs is strictly forbidden at the camp and will result in dismissal without refund. Possession of alcohol on campus is not allowed.
6. Firearms, weapons and fireworks are not permitted on campus.
7. Pets are not permitted in any campus building.
8. Meal/Access card will be issued at registration and must be presented at each meal.
9. Room keys and access cards will be issued to all residential campers. Keys/cards must be returned at camp check-out. A \$100 lock replacement fee will be assessed to all campers who lose a key or leave campus with a key. A \$10 fee will be assessed for any lost or damaged card.
10. Individuals from other camps or communities are not permitted in the *OleChess* residence hall. *OleChess* campers are not allowed in any residence hall other than the one assigned to them.
11. All activities will be finished by 10:00 p.m. and the doors of the residence hall will be locked at that time. All residents will observe quiet time from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
12. Any damage to camp/campus property must be paid for by the camper or the camper's parent or guardian.
13. In addition to these rules, campers are expected to adhere to the rules of conduct set by each instructor for his or her classroom.
14. Instructions of Camp Directors, Counselors, or Campus personnel must be followed.
15. OleChess reserves the right to terminate any camper's participation in the camp at any time.
