

Band • Orchestra • Choir

This performance-based experience will challenge you to stretch your musical abilities as you participate in major ensembles like band, orchestra or choir (you may choose up to two ensembles); string, brass, and woodwind chamber music groups (see class description) ; and private lessons (two 30-minute lessons are included with the tuition, with the option of purchasing two additional lessons), in addition to solo recital opportunities and highly participatory class offerings.
