


- 1. From the Facilities, EHS, Arts, or Laboratory Safety homepages ...





3. Login with your St. Olaf credentials...




4. Click on "St. Olaf Safety Data Sheets" ...


- 5. You will see this main page. You can search using one of two options...

6. USING THE SEARCH BAR

Step 1: Begin typing the name of the chemical...

- Chemical names will populate the field as you type.
- Click on the name of the desired chemical.






6. USING THE SEARCH BAR

Step 2: Use Option A or Option B to find chemical safety info...

(You may need to scroll down the list to find your exact chemical; e.g., if you type in "acetone" the search will return multiple hits since acetone is purchased from more than one vendor)

Option A: Click on the GHS icon to view the SDS


Option B: Click on the chemical name to view a summary of GHS info






6. USING THE SEARCH BAR

Option A: If you click on the GHS Icon ...



Then the SDS will pop up.

- You can view/scroll through it, download it, or print it.
- You can click on the "Open in New Window" for easier access

Option B: If you click on the chemical name...



Then the product & GHS safety info will pop up.





7. SEARCHING BY LOCATION


Click on "All Locations"



7. SEARCHING BY LOCATION

Locations are organized into 3 groups: Facilities, Academics, & Athletics.

- In the example below, we have scrolled down to select the "Disinfectant" category within the "Custodial Services" subgroup of Facilities.
- Click "Apply" after you have selected the category that you want.



- The list of substances within that category will appear.
- You can then click on the substance's GHS icon or it's name.
