For my individual project, I constructed a cedar bench to be placed along the path from Old Main hill to the rear parking lot of Regents Hall. The purpose of the bench is to create a contemplative space on campus out in nature.

There is a value in being out on the natural lands that is not found in the classroom, which is why I wanted to create a space that could allow students to slow down and spend time outside of the conventional academic setting.
