	Accept your financial aid award using Financial Aid Online.
June 1, 2012	Make your second \$300 deposit.
June 15, 2012	Complete and submit:

	All forms should be downloaded and printed from Financial Aid Online and submitted to the Financial Aid Office.
July 1, 2012	Submit your payment method form to TMS if you are selecting monthly or quarterly payment plans.
July 15, 2012	If you have accepted any loans in your financial aid package you will need to apply for them separately. Submit loan applications for Federal Direct loans, Perkins loans, PLUS loans, or student alternative loans electronically at stolaf.edu/services/financialaid/loans.htm.
Late July	Fall semester bill sent to students via email.
Mid-August	Fall semester payments due.
Early September	During student orientation (Week One), two forms of identification will be required to complete an I-9 form before a student can begin working at a campus job. Acceptable forms of identification are a passport, driver's license, birth certificate or Social Security card.
