683 seniors have declared 922 majors and 356 concentrations.

456 (66.8%) seniors have declared **one major**, 215 (31.5%) have declared **two majors**, and 12 (1.8%) have declared **three majors**.

247 (36.2%) have declared **one concentration**, 50 (7.3%) have declared **two concentrations**, and 3 (0.4%) have declared **three concentrations**.

As of today, the **Grade Point Average** for the Class of 2018 is 3.42.

The GPA for the Class of 2017 was 3.43; the GPA for the Class of 2016 was 3.39.

As of today, 256 seniors out of 683 will graduate with honors (37.5%).

Off-Campus Study

Of the 683 seniors, 515 or 75.4% participated in at least one **off-campus Domestic or International program** (Year, Semester, Interim, or Summer). 222 (32.5%) participated in two or more programs.

Domestic off-campus programs – 113 students, 16.5% participation

International off-campus programs – 472 students, 69.1% participation
