


Catalyst

Catalyst is an online catalog containing a list of all books, audio, and video sources the St. Olaf and Carleton libraries currently possess. It is a valuable tool that allows you to locate resources based on the title, author, subject, or call number and is the best resource to locate books. For the best and most accurate results, it is best to be as specific as possible, including as much information as possible in multiple fields.


1. To access Catalyst, go to www.stolaf.edu/library. Select “Advanced Search”




You will arrive at this screen:




- From here, you can narrow your search to be more specific. Select “any field.” You can now narrow your search by title, author, subject, or call number. Use as many lines necessary to narrow your search. The more “fields” you add, the more accurate your results will be.



- Additionally, the options on the side of the screen can also be used to narrow your search. In “material type,” narrow your search by indicating if you are looking for a book/ebook, audio, video, or score. You can also indicate the language the material is in, and the year the item was published. If the year is unknown, the search can also be specified to a range of publication in the last 1, 2, or 5 years.



4. After typing in the information, click “Search.” A list of results will come up, which you can refine on the left-hand side of the screen.



5. A list of results given your search parameters will appear. Identify the material you seek. You can now locate the location of the item, as indicated below. Here, *The Fall* by Albert Camus has been used as an example.
