

Exploring Off-Campus Study Opportunities by Major

A vocational discernment experience is the top-ranked recommendation for our students. In addition to participation in internships and shadowing experiences to achieve this goal, **we highly encourage our majors to study abroad** during their time at St. Olaf College. The flexibility in our curriculum allows this opportunity either during January (Interim) or for a full semester. Students will be exposed to the ways in which other countries study the physiological and functional adaptations to movement. Application Steps

1. **Investigate programs.** Seek out advising from IOS Staff and Program Advisors. Use this time to better explore program options.
2. **Identify the program(s)** that best fit your interest, your needs, and your academic pursuits.
3. **Complete the IOS Application process.** Faculty Program Advisors review and approve applications for St. Olaf students to apply for and study off-campus.
4. **Complete the Secondary Application process.** This is the process of applying directly to the university or program provider, if your program is hosted off-campus.

Note: Scholarships are available for all off-campus study programs.
