Description

The linguistics concentration consists of a minimum of FIVE courses:

(I) LNGST 250: English Language and Linguistics; (2) three approved departmental offerings at any level (with the requirement that students take no more than two of these three courses within the same department); and (3) one approved Level III course. Students may also receive concentration credit through Independent Study, Independent Research, or an internship.

However, students may fulfill a requirement by taking a Category C course that counts for Linguistics Studies <u>after</u> consultation with the instructor and the Director of Linguistic Studies. In order to be qualified as a Category C course, students have to do one of the following: (a) complete a substantive major course requirement by focusing on linguistic oriented content (such as paper and presentation), or (b) undertaking additional work outside of the course requirements.

This form formalizes the agreement between the student, the instructor, and the Director of Linguistic Studies in order to specify (I) the type of work that is assigned to the student for linguistic credit, (2) the way it is evaluated, and (3) the deadline by which to complete the work.
