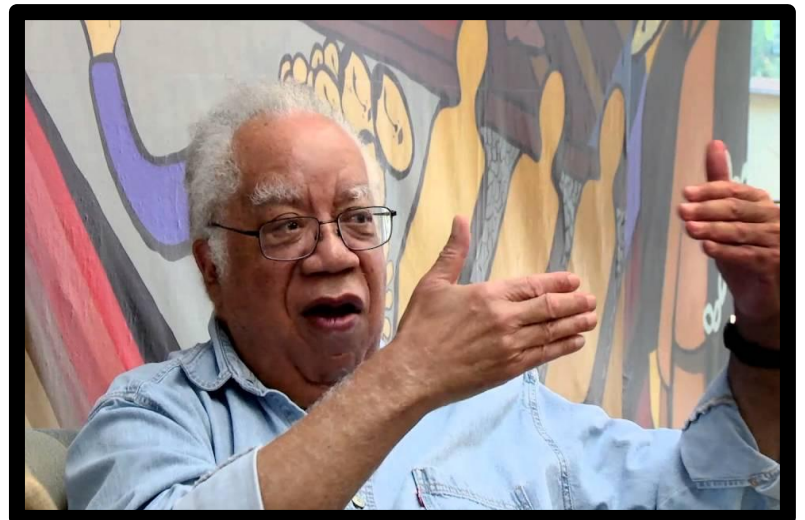
## Godfather of Black Psychology

- Alumnus of the year from San Francisco State University

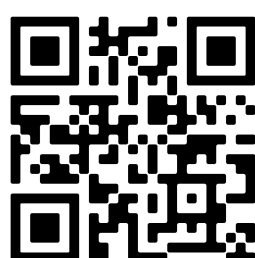
### Contributions
