1 major is required

Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0

Student must have 6 credits graded "C" or above in each major

Minimum total number of credits is 35

18 upper-level credits must be taken (200-level or above)

24 credits must be graded (those cannot be Pass/No Pass or Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory)

No more than 6 credits can be taken Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory

3 Interims must be taken/1 must be taken as a first-year student
