

**Requirements for a Norwegian Major (9 courses)**

A Norwegian Major consists of nine courses in Norwegian language, literature and history.  
 Students are strongly encouraged to study abroad in Norway for a year, semester or summer.  
 If you test into NOR 231 or higher, you can fulfill the major with 8 credits instead of 9.  
 You can use a total of 3 courses from study abroad programs to fulfill these requirements.
