

MY PSYCHOLOGY MAJOR

Use this sheet to plan your schedule and keep track of your progress in the major. Timing shown is ideal; actual timing may vary.

1. One Introductory Course (usually during First year):

- Principles of Psychology* (Psych 125) – this course (or AP Psychology credit score of 4 or 5) is a prerequisite for other Psychology courses.

2. Two Methodology Courses (ideally by end of Sophomore year):

- Statistics* (Stats 172/212, or Stats 110, or Econ 260/263, or AP Statistics credit score of 4 or 5).
 Research Methods (Psych 230; prerequisite is *Statistics*).

3. Three Psychology Core Content Courses: Choose at least 1 each from 3 of the 4 core areas below:

*Note: some core courses are prerequisite for specific 300-level courses, so it is a good idea to complete some core courses before Senior year.

- Most Psychology 300-level courses have *Research Methods* as a prerequisite; check individual course descriptions for additional prerequisites.
- Only 1 research course (e.g., Psych 395, 396, or 398) may count toward this 300-level requirement.
- Psych 394 (*Internship*) counts toward the major but does not count toward this 300-level course requirement.
