### Additional Degree Requirements:

- 1 major
- 2.0 minimum cumulative GPA
- 6 credits graded C or above in the major
- 35 minimum total credits
- 21 credits outside of the major department
- 18 upper-level credits (200-level or above)
- 24 graded credits (not P/F or S/U)
- 6 credits maximum S/U
- 3 interims (1 must be taken the first year)
