Starting a Major or Concentration

- Connect with a member of our faculty to see if one or both courses of study are a fit for you:
- Social Work- a professional program
- Family Studies- intensive study in family social science

First Year: Must, Should, Can

- For Social Work:
- Must- there are no courses you must take
- Should- begin prerequisite courses, i.e. Psych 125 and So/An 121
- Can take other Ole Core classes

First Year: Must, Should, Can

- For Family Studies:
- Must- there are not courses you must take
- Should- take FAMST 132, Intro to Family Studies
- Can take other Ole Core classes, and those for your major

Receiving Credit for Previous Work

For Social Work, you may use AP credit for the prerequisite courses like Psychology 125

- Credit transfer is handled by the registrar's office
- There are not placement exams for Social Work or Family Studies.
