## Required “Core” Courses for Spanish Major\*

One of the following: Spanish 313 (Literature & Society in Spain / counts as a course with a focus on Spain, ALS-L) or Spanish 314 (Literature & Society in Latin America / counts as a course with a focus on Latin America, ALS-L)

## Elective Courses for Major

Students choose 3 electives at the 270-level or higher and an additional elective must be at the 300-level.  
(Students may take 313 or 314 more than once as electives, provided a different topic is offered.)
