Please consult the handout "Off-Campus Study and the Spanish Major" and **meet with the Chair of Romance Languages before leaving for an off-campus program** to discuss appropriate courses for the major.

Due to the scheduling requirements of the Nursing Major, nursing students will be unable to complete a double major in Nursing and Spanish in 4 years.
