The STEM SI will serve as a Supplemental Instruction Leader, academic tutor for incoming first-year students, and assistant the SSS summer faculty and staff. Qualifications, duties, and responsibilities are listed below.

- Possess good organizational skills, solid academic background in Biology and/or Chemistry, and a willingness to help other students learn.
- Must exhibit professionalism and personal qualities necessary for working with students and staff during and after the Summer Bridge Program.
- Be sensitive to the needs of first generation college students, representing diverse ethnic/cultural backgrounds.
