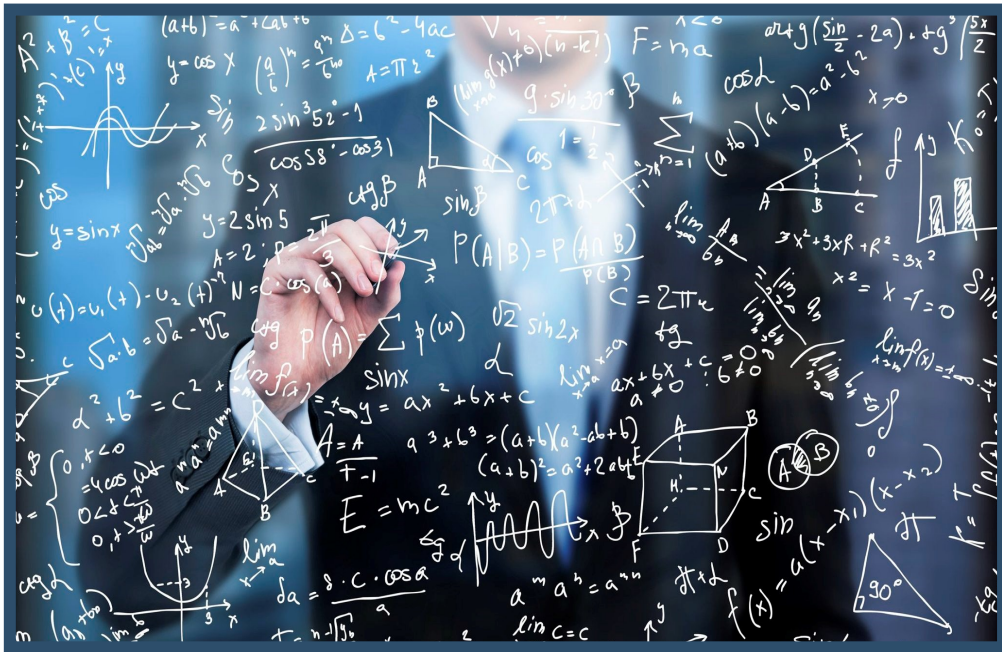


Some lessons learned in over twenty years as a quant
